

Instructions to authors in Entomologisk Tidskrift (October 2007)

General. Read this page before you submit your manuscript. In addition you can use a paper already published in Ent. Tidskr. as an example of how a paper should be formatted.

Most papers in Entomologisk Tidskrift are written in Swedish. Papers with an interantional interest should however be in English and also papers written by non-Scandinavian authors can be in English. Articles in English are always accompanied by a summary in Swedish, with which the author can get help from the editor.

Manuscripts well be accepted (often after som revisions) or rejected by decision of the editor, usually based on reports from two referees.

Manuscripts should be clearly written, and use of illustrations, including coloured pictures, is encouraged.

Formatting the manuscript

The manuscript shall begin with the following things, in the order they are mentioned: Title, name of authors, titles in both English and Swedish (editor can translate), abstract and adresses of author(s). Abstract is always in English and should not exceed 200 words.

Text, should be written with double line space. The only formatting that should be done by the author are row breaks in end of paragraphs, *italic* and **bold** text. Other formatting is done by the editor after the final accepted version is submitted.

Scientific names on genera and species should be written in *italics*.

Lists of records must be structured in a consequent order according to the pattern: "**Country: Province Parish** Locality, other circumstances, Date (collector), Locality for next record..." etc. The provinces shall be sorted geographically, parishes shall be sorted alphabetically or geographically. Parishes can be substituted by municipalities (but it must be consequent through the whole paper). Coordinates can also be attached.

References are listed after the main text. All references shall be cited in the text and vice versa. Below are examples of how references should be formatted (journal paper, book, and book section).

Nilsson, L.A. & Cederberg, B. 2001. *Nomada fucata*, ett för Sverige nytt gökbi (Hymenoptera: Anthophoridae). – Ent. Tidskr. 123: 19-22.

Trägårdh, I. 1939. Sveriges skogsinsekter. 2:a uppl. – Hugo Geber, Stockholm.

Stephens, J.M. 1963. Immunity in insects. – In: Steinhaus, E.A. (ed.). Insect pathology. An advanced treatise. Vol. 1: 273-297. Academic Press, New York.

In the text citations should be formatted as: Trägårdh (1939), (Trägårdh 1939) or if specific pages should be cited: Trägårdh (1939: 285-287). Citations with more than one author shall be formatted as (Nilsson & Cederberg 2001) or (Franzén et al. 2002).

Tables shall be placed on separate pages after the reference list. Table legend and if needed, column headings should be given also in Swedish. (editor can help with this). Tables are numbered with arabic letters and all tables shall be cited in the text as "Table 1".

Figures (maps, graphs, drawings and photos) should preferably be used. These are placed in the end of the manuscript in the submitted version, or in a separate figure file (preferably pdf in that case). In the submitted version it is enough with pictures of low resolution. High resolution files or originals of pictures can be mailed after the manuscript is accepted. Also the figure legends should be bilingual (editor can give help). Figures are numbered with arabic numbers, and sub-figures shall be marked with letters (i.e. 1 a,b,c if there are three subfigures in Fig. 1). All figures shall be cited in the text as "Fig. 1".

Proportions of figures shall be adjusted to the format of the Ent. Tidskr. pages: Column width = 70 mm, page with 140 mm, page height 195 mm. The figures can however be enlarged or reduced by the editor.

In the final version pictures must have resolution enough for good result in the printing. For photos 300 dpi are desired and for line art 800 dpi. That means that a photo that covers one page (=two columns) should have 1660 pixels in breadth. Fileformat for pictures can be tiff (preferred), high quality jpg, Photoshop, EPS or pdf. Ask the editor if you have questions about pictures.

Submission of manuscripts

Manuscripts shall be sent to the editor as an electronic file. Address:

Manuscripts shall have double space between lines and large margins. For text files submission can be done in most word-processor formats, preferably with pages and lines numbered. Figures can be glued in in the end of the manuscript. The manuscript can also be submitted as one text file and one figure file (but not several figure files).

Page proofs. Authors will get one page proof before the article is printed. All corrections must be marked there. Changes compared to the final version of the manuscript can not be done.

Reprint. After publication, authors receive 50 free reprints of the article. More reprints can be ordered according to a price list. A pdf-file of the article can also be sent (free).
